OVERVIEW

Campus-based network repeatedly cited for promoting antisemitic rhetoric and intimidating Jewish students under the guise of activism.

THREAT ASSESSMENT

Students for Justice in Palestine has been documented engaging in coordinated antisemitic activity. Activities tracked include public propaganda dissemination, intimidation campaigns, and targeted harassment of Jewish communities, institutions, and individuals.

DOCUMENTED ACTIVITY

StopAntisemitism maintains an evolving evidentiary record drawn from open-source intelligence, victim testimony, and public statements made by the group and its affiliated leadership. The record is updated as new incidents are verified.

METHODOLOGY

Designations are made under StopAntisemitism's published criteria for antisemitic extremism. All cited incidents are corroborated by at least two independent sources prior to inclusion in the dossier.
